The *Owen MacLennan Trade Unionist of the Year Award* was established in 2020, to acknowledge and celebrate individual trade unionists who have made a significant and/or ongoing contribution to the labour movement. This annual award was created in loving memory of Owen MacLennan who passed away in 2010.

Owen MacLennan worked at Eastern Bakeries from 1951 to 1994. He had a strong work ethic and was an active member of the *Bakery, Confectionary, Tobacco Workers and Grain Millers Union (BCTGM)* local 406 in Moncton.

A donation in the amount of \$1,000 will be made by Argus Audiology in the name of the award recipient to the New Brunswick Federation of Labour (NBFL) Blair Doucet Youth Summer Camp. The presentation of the award will be made during labour day weekend each year. Award recipients will also be formally be recognized during the NBFL Convention.

- ✓ Nominations accepted from union locals and labour councils affiliated to the NBFL;
- ✓ Nominee must be an individual, either a member or staff of an affiliated union local, who has not previously received this award;
- ✓ Nominee is committed to furthering diversity/inclusion in the workplace and to promoting social justice;
- ✓ Nominee is passionate about breaking down barriers, bringing about legislative reforms, creating actions and campaigns to mobilize members around common objectives.
- ✓ Nominee has demonstrated leadership capabilities and years of service in the labour movement.

Nomination Process:
