The **Daniel Legere Memorial Scholarship** is valued at \$2,500 and is offered annually. The objective of the award is to honour past New Brunswick Federation of Labour (NBFL) President Daniel Legere, a dedicated union activist, by supporting students enrolled in post-secondary studies who are committed to social justice and community engagement.

Applicants must be a New Brunswick resident, with a parent or legal guardian who is a member of a labour union affiliated with the NBFL. They must be enrolled or accepted into a recognized post-secondary institution on a full-time basis. It is open to students at all stages of their post-secondary studies. Past recipients of this award are not eligible to receive it again.

Applicants must return a completed application form and fully comply with all entry rules. **Deadline for receipt of entries is June 30th each year.**

The successful applicant will be notified when a decision is reached and an official announcement of the winner will be made by the Secretary-Treasurer of the New Brunswick Federation of Labour.

Entry Rules

- Application forms **MUST** be supported by the following:
 1. An essay of 500 to 1,000: **“Describe how and why you are involved in community activism and/or with an organization working towards social justice. How do you embody solidarity with the labour movement?”**
 2. A letter of reference from a labour representative, teacher or community leader.
- Preliminary judging of entries will be by an academic/arts panel and the final selection will be made by the NBFL Education Committee.
- The winning entry shall be released to the media.
- Applicants agree to allow display of their entry at the annual NBFL convention.
- Entries, if requested, will be returned at the applicant’s expense.
- Applicant agrees that their essay is their own work, written in their own words, without the use of Chat GPT or other artificial intelligence, and that quoted material from websites or other sources are identified and credited.
